# PEOPLES CONGREGATIONAL UNITED CHURCH OF CHRIST

The Peoples Congregational United Church of Christ Scholarship Committee is pleased to announce Book Grant Applications for Church Scholarship Recipients who meet the eligibility requirements. This Book Grant is for eligible students, enrolled in an accredited post-secondary degree/certificate granting program. Please review the guidelines below to determine your eligibility. Eligible applicants must submit their completed Book Grant Application and a copy of their Spring 2023 school registration or other evidence of enrollment in good standing. Submissions must be received **NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, JANUARY 27, 2023, AT 11:59 PM EST** (no exceptions).

## **Eligibility Guidelines**

1. The applicant must be a **<u>Peoples Church Member</u>** who received a Scholarship in 2018, 2019, 2020 or 2021. Alternatively, the Book Grant applicant must have joined Peoples Congregational UCC by the process of Confirmation or by Public Affirmation, at a Sunday morning worship service, prior to January 27, 2023, deadline.

2. All Book Grant Applications and supporting documents must be received by **JANUARY 27, 2023, at 11:59 pm EST**.

3. The recipient must be enrolled at an accredited post-secondary degree/certificate granting program, and *must plan to return to school for the Spring 2023 semester.* By submitting this application, the applicant affirms that s/he will return to school next semester. As a note, students who have already earned a Bachelor's degree are not eligible to receive a book grant.

4. Students are eligible for a total of up to five Peoples UCC monetary awards from the Scholarship Committee, only one of which may be a scholarship (i.e., five book grants, or one scholarship and four book grants, in any order). No student may receive more than one award – a scholarship or a book grant – in the same calendar year. For example, if you received a scholarship in June 2022, you are *not* eligible to apply for a book grant this year.

# <u>Instructions for Submitting Book Grant Applications via Online Form</u> (PREFERRED METHOD)

## Instructions for Submitting Book Grant Applications via E-mail

If unable to submit application and supporting material via the online form, students are able to submit the Book Grant applications and supporting materials via e-mail (**scholarship@peopleschurchucc.org**). Perform the following steps to submit the Book Grant application and supporting materials via e-mail:

- 1) Complete 'fillable' Book Grant Application, including signature (may type in name for signature).
- 2) Obtain Supporting Materials for the Book Grant applications.
- 3) Create E-mail and enter Applicant's Name and the title 'Book Grant Application' in the Subject Line (e.g., Book Grant Application Jane Doe).
- 4) Attach Book Grant Application and Supporting Materials to e-mail created.
- 5) Enter brief description of the Book Grant application in the body of the e-mail.
- 6) Click 'Send' to send the e-mail. Note: All applications and materials must be received by FRIDAY, JANUARY 27, 2023, AT 11:59 PM EST.
- 7) A confirmation e-mail will be sent to the applicant once the application has been received. The applicant bears the duty to confirm that the Committee has received their application.

**Note:** Hard copies of this Book Grant Application are available outside the Peoples Congregational UCC office.

## **Instructions for Submitting Book Grant Applications via Postal Mail**

If unable to submit application and supporting material via the online form, students are able to submit the Book Grant applications and supporting materials via postal mail. Perform the following steps to submit the Book Grant application via regular postal mail:

- 1) Complete Book Grant Application (please print information), including signature.
- 2) Obtain Supporting Materials for the Book Grant applications.
- 3) Make copies of the Book Grant Application and the supporting materials.
- 4) Mail original copies of the Book Grant Application and the supporting materials to the following address:

- 5) Send a confirmation e-mail to the Scholarship Committee (scholarship@peopleschurchucc.org) with <u>Applicant's Name and title 'Book</u> <u>Grant Application Mailed'</u> in subject line to advise the committee that the application and supporting materials have been mailed (e.g. Book Grant Application Mailed – Jane Doe).
- 6) Click 'Send' to send the e-mail.
- 7) A confirmation e-mail will be sent to the applicant, once the application has been received. The applicant bears the duty to confirm that the Committee has received their application.

# Instructions for Submitting Book Grant Application In-Person

If unable to submit application and supporting material via the online form, students are able to submit the Book Grant applications and supporting materials via inperson at the church. Perform the following steps to submit the Book Grant application in-person:

- 1) Complete Book Grant Application (please print information), including signature.
- 2) Obtain Supporting Materials for the Book Grant applications.
- 3) Make copies of the Book Grant Application and the supporting materials.
- 4) Insert the Book Grant Application and the supporting materials into a large brown envelope.
- 5) Address Envelope to the Attn: Scholarship Committee: Book Grant Application
- 6) Bring envelope with the original copies of the Book Grant Application and the supporting materials to the following address (main office):

# Note: All applications and materials submitted in-person must be received by FRIDAY, JANUARY 27, 2023, AT 5:00 PM EST.

7) Insert the envelope into the box labeled 'Book Grant Applications' or request it be placed in the 'Scholarship Committee' mailbox.

- 8) Send a confirmation e-mail to the Scholarship Committee

  (scholarship@peopleschurchucc.org) with Applicant's Name and title 'Book
  Grant Application In-Person' in subject line to advise the committee that the application and supporting materials have been delivered to the church and placed in the Book Grant Application box. (e. g. Book Grant Application In-Person Jane Doe).
- 9) Click 'Send' to send the e-mail.
- 10) A confirmation e-mail will be sent to the applicant once the application has been received. The applicant bears the duty to confirm that the Committee has received their application.

# Selection/Notification of Book Grant Awards

Recipients of the Book Grant Awards will be notified via e-mail of their award in February 2023. The Scholarship Committee retains the final decision to award Book Grants based on eligibility. As a note, students may be required to submit a W-9 form required by IRS for taxable scholarships and grants.
