

PEOPLES CHURCH RE-OPENING PHASE 2 (JUNE 2021)

Peoples Congregational United Church of Christ (PCUCC) is following the Central Atlantic Conference, CDC and DC Government guidelines for Communities of Faith. In addition, we will implement specific protocols:

- ✦ **Sanctuary Gatherings:** Maximum 50 people (not including Clergy)
- ✦ **Garden Gatherings:** Maximum 15 people (not including Clergy)
- ✦ **Parking Lot Gatherings:** Maximum 50 people (not including Clergy)
- ✦ Practice social distancing. Stay at least 6 feet from other people when possible.
- ✦ Wear a proper face covering.
- ✦ Individuals experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, or recently exposed to someone diagnosed with COVID-19 must not work or visit a place of worship due to the risk of exposing others.

Registration is required for ALL Gatherings.

For individuals with special needs, accommodations will be available.

MASK ARE REQUIRED. ALL PERSONS MUST WEAR A MASK/FACE COVERING FOR BOTH IN-PERSON AND OUTDOOR EVENTS.

To protect the safety and well-being of our children and their families, we are limiting indoor activities. No in-person singing is allowed. Virtual children's choirs and programs are encouraged. Limited outdoors activities are allowed with permission from the Ministers. When children are gathering outdoors all social distancing rules and procedures apply.

DC Government has stated that CDC Guidelines should be followed regarding children reopening activities and programs. Limited Indoors and outdoor activities for children are permissible excluding choral singing. Masks and social distancing protocols must be followed, as well as the DC guidelines for childcare.

Considerations are being made for limited group singing for vaccinated individuals, which may begin in June to record for Sunday Worship.

- A maximum of 4 individuals at any time.
- Proof of vaccination will be required.

Please be advised that these guidelines will continuously be updated based on DC Government guidelines. But PCUCC will NOT be starting full in-person service until later in the year based on CDC and/or DC Government guidelines.
