### Message from Reverend Brandon Harris:

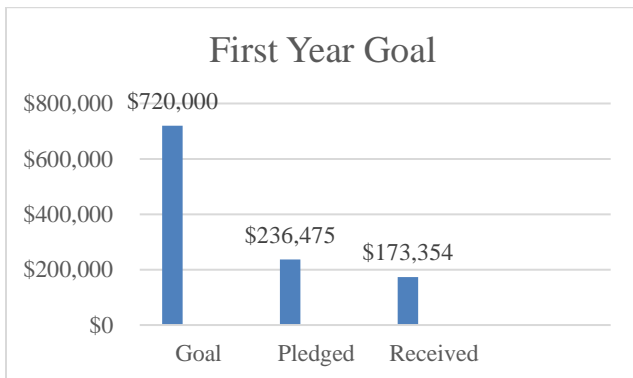


Dear beloved Church family, our capital campaign is an essential part of our continued growth and future as a community of faith! Peoples is a wonderful congregation with a strong

### OUR GOAL

The goal of the Capital Campaign Community of Faith (CCCOF) is to raise \$1.5M before March 31, 2021 to eliminate our Church mortgage and to pay for the needed replacement of the HVAC for our Church.



### HVAC HIGHLIGHTS

These phases will be accomplished between January through April 2020.

- Phase 1: Completion of Elmes Center facility spaces. Closure of ceiling grids
- Phase 2: Completion of Sanctuary within one week.
- Phase 3: Completion of Lower Auditorium

After completion of HVAC installation, the beautification phase will include painting, clean-up and replacement of materials as needed.
