

OUR GOAL

The goal of the Capital Campaign Community of Faith (CCCOF) is to raise \$1.5M before March 31, 2021 to eliminate our Church mortgage and to pay for the needed replacement of the HVAC for our Church.



HIGHLIGHTS

- March 3, 2019 Founders' Day and 128th Church Anniversary, the CCCOF was launched, blessed and commissioned. CCCOF members were introduced to the congregation.
- March 30, 2019 Inaugural Meeting for the CCCOF was to form strategies to attain the goal of loan repayment and to identify work groups, such as, Public Relations and Marketing, Multimedia Technology, and Community Outreach.
- Using the base of 400 active members; 76 pledge cards have been submitted to date. Total amount pledged as of June 16, 2019 is \$167,650; total received and deposited as of June 16, 2019 is \$40.570

WHAT'S NEXT?

- Multimedia Technology Team will have text-giving and crowdfunding revenue streams activated by mid-July.
- The Church School children (Children Changers) have received their coin jars and will collect loose change over the summer and will make their first deposit in September.
- The Community Outreach Team will send appeal letters to Church Organizations, Church Contractors/Vendors, Professional Organizations and Community Partners over the next few weeks.
- The CCCOF will send a mass mailing with the pledge card to the full congregation by mid-July. If you have pledged already, use the pledge card to request a donation from your family/friend circles.
