

Affordable housing is an ongoing concern for DC residents in Ward 4 and throughout the DMV. Longterm tenants and senior homeowners are being

pushed out. First time homeowners (to be!) and young families are being priced out of Ward 4 and the city at-large.

It will describe initiatives underway to prevent further displacement of longtime DC residents and promote opportunities for homeownership and renter affordability.
