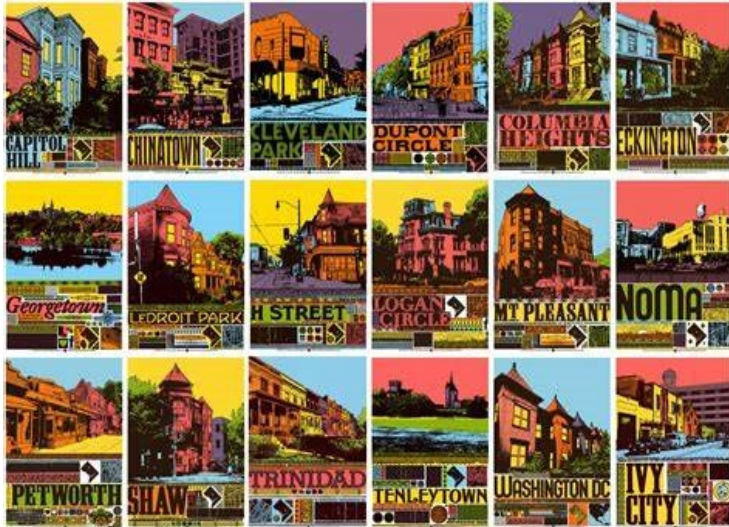

Affordable housing is an ongoing concern for DC residents in Ward 4 and throughout the city. Long-term tenants and senior homeowners are being pushed out. First time homeowners (to be!) and young families are being priced out of Ward 4 and the city at-large.
